 - Sworn in as senators on the floor. Congratulations everyone!
- General Assembly meeting next week is cancelled due to Fall Break travel
- Executive Council starting office hours soon (1 hour per week per EC member)
- o Mask Ordinance extended to Jan. 9, 202. We did it!
- o COVID-19 Giveaway Program distribution
 - Allowing 400 tickets to be distributed per week. 200 are registered each week
 - If 5/10 get registered, you will be entered into raffle to win Drury hoodie
 - If 10/10 get registered, you get additional chance for the hoodie
- o Still recruiting new SGA members in each class, please refer them to drury.sga.edu

- o Official SGA pictures will be taken by VP Greer, ask Greer if you need it taken

- - Difficult to recruit new freshmen because of COVID-19

Old Business

- Vice President Greer: Step N' Pull
 - o Brandon Gammill agreed to reduce amount to 95 pulls at \$22.46 a piece
 - o Total amount is \$2,228.70
 - Senator Altahafi- why do we need custom engraving?
 - VP Greer- it is \$100 and would make it nicer
 - o Step N' Pull sign included with each unit to place on door
 - o Senator Rispoli- we should invest in an SGA decal on the door, rather than on the pull
 - VP Hammer- motions to keep proposal but add SGA logo on the sticker decal
 - Failed
 - Senator Altahafi- no engraving, but add customized engraving/decal?
 - Idea= No engraving, but have sticker instead for the same cost
 - Senator Parrish- keep it how it is and get it with paw print. Customization can go to a specific committee
 - VP Mueller- we should not place SGA logo on sticker
 - Senator Clouse- every student got an SGA water bottle, and logo would help advertise SGA. We should not delay ordering them any further, we need them ASAP
 - VP Greer- concerned about Drury allowing stickers on door
 - Current motion on the floor is to amend the proposal to add SGA stickers instead of engraving
 - Failed
 - Original project proposal
 - Passed

New Business

\$1,000 proposals

- Senator O'Brien- Drury SGA app
 - Will allow information to be more accessible to students and increase SGA exposure
 - "Main policy is to have feedback form accessible to students"
 - All-on-one app for students
 - Student feedback for idea
 - o COVID-19 information
 - Student feedback
 - o Drury schedule
 - Club/organization info
 - Fraternity/sorority information
 - App already partially designed, including log-in screen and registration
 - Senator O'Brien- Cost- \$25 one-time fee and \$99 per year
 - Senator Parrish- who will be responsible for running the app?
 - o Senator O'Brien- Either VP Hammer or the marketing department
 - VP Hammer- We need to establish who will be responsible for the app five years down the road, e.g. the university marketing department
 - Senator O'Brien- Will consider reaching out to university
 - Senator Gabriel- similar to Fanther's app, and the Drury app must be better in order to succeed
 - o Senator O'Brien- Agreed with statement
 - Senator Rispoli- It is a great idea to work with faculty/staff to regularly meeting to discuss app progress. Who will you reach to next? Great initiating steps, Thomas!
 - Senator O'Brien- VP Hammer and Senator Leiva have helped discuss, but app is a broad subject
 - Senator Keith- reaching out to Fanthers to combine is a great idea. It would be nice to have condensed place for information
- Paused meeting to sanitize tables
 - VP Greer- We should remand to committee to further discuss the app
 - Senator Ahmed- motioned and seconded to remand proposal to the Communication and PR committee
 - Seconded and passed
 - Senator Williams- Water bottle filling stations proposal
 - This is the first phase for the project, other residential buildings will come later
 - Goal is for all residential buildings to have fillable stations with clean water
 - Four units should be purchased for each fraternity house in phase one
 - Total cost is being decided with Brandon Gammill
 - As of now, total is \$2,152.05 not including installation
 - Senator Rispoli- Roadmap would be nice to see where stations should be installed and when
 - As of now, first phase is fraternity houses

- Senator Ahmed motions to remand the proposal to committee for further discussion
 - Seconded and passed
- Moved time cap from 6:00 to 6:30

Open Discussion

- Senator Schupbach- Student Affairs Committee (SAC)
 - 2 Organizations awaiting approval
 - John Gray and Corbin Z. desiring to create two religious clubs on campus
 - o The Claw (Corbin Z.) advisor is currently Amanda Bollinger
 - o John Gray's club advisor is Jennifer Stewart
 - o Did not pass since inclusivity was questioned in both organizations
 - University standing
 - o Panel who reviews us usually visits with students
 - o This year there may be no student in the process
 - Accreditation will occur later in November
 - Senator Altahafi- wants to bring speaker to campus that involves inclusion and diversity
 - Wants to have discussion panel that affects minority groups
 - Purpose? Discussion panel on race (while working with professors and African-American community)
 - "I am an immigrant and a person of color" and Senator Altahafi wants
 to do this to benefit the campus community as a whole
 - o VP Greer-Should be taken to a committee for further discussion
 - Paul Hinkle- Student voices are the loudest to speak, but should reach out to Dr. Cloyd to keep this process going
 - Senator Harless- Mural proposal update
 - Competition among students vs. hiring muralist? Thoughts?
 - Senator Keith- "For the students, by the students" is important
 - Great work Senator Harless, we are excited!
