• Executive Council Reports

- - Blackbear Concert Updates
 - this past week the EC has been scrambling to make the concert happen after abrupt notice Monday night, October 25th, that blackbear needed to cancel; had emergency meetings all day on Tuesday, October 26th; Wednesday October 27th had an artist approved an announced,

- deferred to Pres. Hall about further updates that occurred the morning of Thursday, October 28th
 - impressed to SENATORS that this news CANNOT leave the GA mtg room, announced that JAX will now be main opener with DJ CEO as the opener, due to B.o.B. being dropped by university after further examination of whether or not his values aligned with the university's (B.o.B. has a history of being anti-semetic)
- tickets for blackbear then B.o.B. concerts have all been refunded, tickets to see JAX will be \$20.00 at the door, all Drury students will now get in free with proof of student id

- Academic Affairs Committee | Senator Garrett Weber
 - integrated business major proposal in-progress,
 - goal is to offer to business majors the ability to have a more immersive experience by dipping their hand in each of the 6 specializations (Finance, Cyber-Security, Economics, Marketing, Management, Accounting),
 - this will allow them to have a more diverse background to draw from when heading into their career field, as a business degree is highly open-ended with what can be done with it

■ FUSE Certificates

 seeking to expand what certificates are offered, can't do that until issues with Watermark resolved

Watermark

- teachers aren't using this program so adjustments needed in current FUSE curriculum is hard to identify,
- Watermark is being required for FUSE professors in their evaluation rubrics this fall

- Student Health & Public Safety Committee | VP Harless
 - student opinion on mask-mandate
 - looking toward next semester, drawing from other universities - Mizzou has dropped their mandate
- Food Committee | VP Vonder Haar
 - x2 new vending machines on campus, with fresh food items as opposed to shelf-stable dry goods items (in College Park SUB Station & in Hammons School of Architecture), Panther Bucks can be used on these
 - Fresh Ideas was supposed to keep funding compostable to-go boxes after SGA passed a one-time purchase of those last semester, but they have returned to using styrofoam boxes, we expressed sustainability is a goal of ours,
 - meetings are open to anyone who wants to join!! check the Teams channel for it


